On the Move **AT YORKVILLE COLLEGE**

Yorkville College is on the move! Because of growth in their dental hygiene diploma program, as well as the introduction of new programs, the college has recently moved to a larger facility. Gwen Seal, president of Yorkville College, says they're almost completely moved in to their new site at 1835 Yonge Street, at Yonge and Davisville in Toronto. "It's brand new and it's gorgeous!" she says.

The move has allowed the college to expand its dental hygiene clinic, from 15 up to 20 chairs. This is a full, state-of-the-art clinic, with three X-ray units in addition to the 20 dental units.

As well as the dental hygiene program, the college offers programs such as paralegal diploma, community and social services worker, pharmacy assistant, dental chairside, as well as its new early childhood assistant program.

Seal says she's also excited about

Yorkville's upcoming computer networking program, consisting of nine industry certifications and one college diploma. "This is the biggest networking program in the province," she says. "No other college offers this many." Students will complete 51 weeks of programming and be Microsoft- and Cisco-certified once they've finished. This will allow graduates to find work in computer network management and operations, so that they can help companies manage their online businesses and make them secure and accessible.

"This program will be jam-packed," Seal says. "It's perfect for someone who doesn't want to leave work for too long but wants to gain the industry certifications." The computer networking program is pending ministry approval, and Seal expects the approval to come shortly. Yorkville is also awaiting approval for its 3D Animation for Video Games program.
